Procedure

Action	Time	Responsibility
1a. Applicant to submit application form, payment, registration fee, and criminal record check to CDPEI. 1b. Applicant to request all current registrations with college/association(s) to send Labour Mobility Verification Form to CDPEI (form is only valid for one month from the date of completion).	n/a	Applicant
2. Upon receipt of application package (as outlined in 1a) and Labour Mobility Verification Form (1b), Registrar/Deputy Registrar determines eligibility.	1 to 2 weeks	Registrar/Deputy Registrar
3. Deposit fees.	1 week	Treasurer
4. Confirm registration and send registration certificate, receipt of payment, and General Member Welcome Letter document electronically to registrant. Assign a membership number in the online register.	1 week	Registrar/Deputy Registrar
